4) Packing List.

Ten Essentials: DAY PACK (will contain all of the following items)

1. Water Bottle (Dishwasher Safe, 32 oz - 36 oz)
2. Duct Tape (Tip: roll onto a pen, lighter or hiking stick) 6 ft Required FVF \$.75
3. Whistle FVF \$1.50-\$2.00
4. Travel size First Aid Kit FVF \$3.00
5. Beanie (Recommend: Synthetic Blend or Wool)
6. Gloves (Recommend: Synthetic Blend or Wool)
7. Windbreaker / Rain Jacket
8. Wrist Watch (not your cell phone)
9. Flashlight (bring extra batteries)

Clothing:

1. Sweater(s)
2. Snow pants
3. Windbreaker
4. #2 extra shirts (Athletic Material, Long sleeved recommended)
5. #2 warm pants (Jeans not recommended)

6. #4 pairs of socks
7. Extra undergarments
8. Shoes with ankle support

Things to Bring to Trip :

1. Sandals/Slippers (to let shoes air out)
2. Sleeping bag(provided by FVF). Optional additions for comfort: blanket & pillow
3. Ten Essentials
4. \$15- \$20 Money
5. Toiletries (Toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush or comb, face wash, hair ties, baby wipes or hand sanitizer, toilet paper (put in a ziploc bag), lotion, Chapstick, deodorant, menstruation products)
6. Chapstick
7. Plastic Grocery Bags (2+). Bag for trash and dirty clothes
8. Medication: If needed
9. BRING YOUR OWN TOWEL
10. indoor slippers

Optional:

1. Camera
2. HOMEWORK (Yes, you will have time to do it!)
3. Sunblock
4. Sun Hat
5. Sun Glasses

House Rules

1. **Please respect the House.** This is for all Venturers and alumni to enjoy.
2. **Quiet time** 10:00 pm; **Bedtime** 11:00 pm unless we have approved activities. Please be mindful of breakfast groups that sleep earlier to get started earlier
3. Conserve water when possible. Take quick showers. Turn off water when you are washing your hair and body. **Don't leave** water running when brushing teeth. No washing clothes.
4. Adults 25 years and older and married couples are allowed in bedrooms. Boys downstairs, girls in middle level. Mid-level restroom can be used by both. Young adult guest/ Alumni under the age of 21 in the living room near Kitchen. 21 and older may stay in the Alumni Lake house.
5. **Keep your area clean.** Pick up and fold your sleeping bag/blanket and place it on top of your bag neatly away from the foot traffic. Make sure that your stuff is not on top of anything that might break or fall.
6. **Use coasters** to prevent condensation from cold cups on furniture.
- 7 Air conditioning/heating is always on. **Close windows**, especially at night. Boys: double check windows or you will freeze.
8. Use your own TOWELS. **DO NOT** use Felix's towels to dry yourself. Please make sure that you do not leave wet towels on furniture. Hang towels and clothes outside to dry.
9. **Dry yourself off before entering the house.** Do not sit on chairs if your bottom is still wet!

10. **Ask** someone how to use or where to find equipment in the kitchen if you do not know.
Trash compactor bags need to be checked and replaced!
11. **Recycle** aluminum, glass and plastics in a container that is located in the island lower corner across from the sink. Throw trash in the trash compactor. { show new ventures where this is located.
12. **Save & wash your cups**, utensils. Use SHARPIE to write your name on your CUP, only. Everyone is responsible for washing and drying plates, cup, and utensils they have used. Stack up the plates and cups neatly.
13. **Don't just grab** food. Ask, have COURTESY!
14. Restrooms: please make sure that everything goes down the toilet and refill the restroom with toilet paper rolls, keep sinks clean and dry after washing hands. **Used toilet paper goes in the toilet, NOT in the wastebasket!**
15. Limit T.V. use. Please take advantage of other activities. House games. Hiking trails, Lake area - always inform an adult and never leave alone.
16. Laptops are **not allowed** unless you have to do homework. Confirm with Adult Staff.
17. Ask before using Jacuzzi. **Do not touch controls**, ask Felix or one of the Staff Members It is recommended to drink water prior entering Jacuzzi. 30 min max time limit.
18. **Don't enter** the lake without letting an adult know. A designated lifeguard is required to swim in the lake. You must stay in sight of the lifeguard and do not go past the "No Wake/ 5 MPH" buoy.
19. **If you need something, ASK!!!!**

5) FVF Policies Review

LOST AND FOUND POLICY: Anything left behind on trips will go to the Felix Ventures Foundation Lost and Found. You have 7 days to claim your things before it is donated to the Salvation Army.

ELECTRONICS POLICY: No use of Phones, iPods, or Gaming Devices allowed DURING any FVF activities. Phone Use will ONLY be allowed in case of emergency. (you got lost in the bike trail)

DAMAGED EQUIPMENT/LOSS POLICY: We have checked all of our equipment. (What's broken, fixed, and etc.) You must return given equipment in the same condition it was given to you. You will be charged for returned damaged equipment. If you receive any equipment that already has any damage, let quartermasters, SPL, or any staff know immediately to avoid any charges.

72 HOURS CANCELLATION POLICY: If for any reason you are no longer able to attend this trip, you must let one of the staff and or officers in charge know at least 72 hrs. before the trip. If you fail to do so, you will be penalized with negative points and may be placed in the alternate list for the next trip.

VOLUNTEER ONE HOUR AFTER TRIP: All students attendees will be required to volunteer ONE hour after the trip, preferably during equipment cleaning. Students who help clean will receive a camp combo card. Collect 5 stamps and get a FREE In-n-out combo. For students who cannot attend the equipment cleaning day,

they will still be required to come into the office and help for ONE hour. Completion of the hour must be done within 5 days of the trip. Consequences will be given to students who fail to complete the requirement.

CLEANING CAR POLICY: After all Felix Ventures activities. Venturers are required to clean (vacuum) the vehicle used for the activity. You cannot get picked up until it is DONE.
